

The baskets are dyed with local nut shells. Marilyn boils the shells several hours in a big black kettle.



Then she strains the shells out. When the dye is boiling again, Marilyn usually dips the whole basket into the dye. Choose from pecan, black walnut or leave it natural.

To Collins


